The Cast Iron Powerglide is a two speed automatic transmission designed by General Motors. It was available primarily on Chevrolet automobiles from 1950 through to 1962.

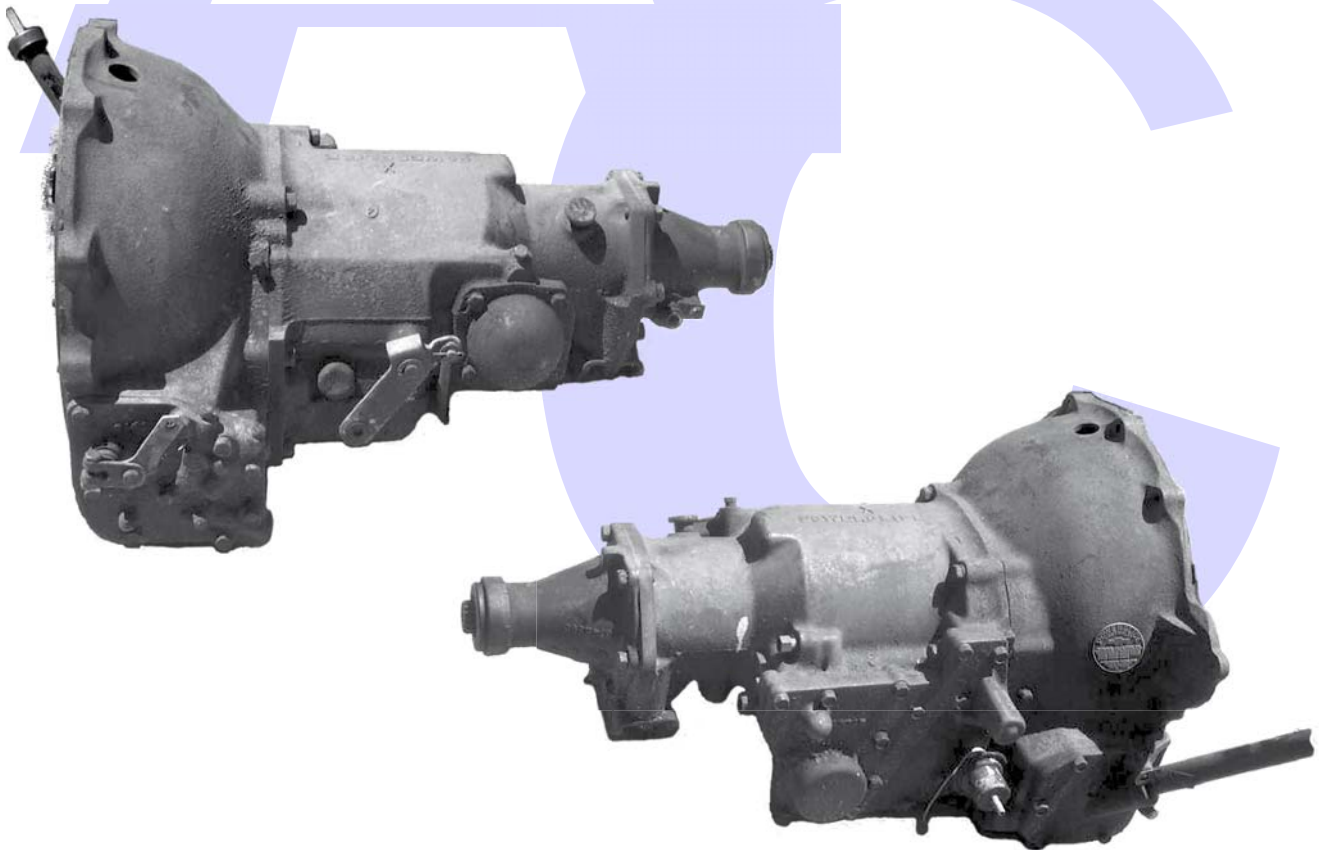
FEATURES
